By Design

Today God made it clear that he is the Creator and Grand Director and Susan and I were smack in the middle of his plan. We volunteer through the Ronald McDonald House to visit families whose children are in the hospital. We usually bring a bag of chocolates and open ears to listen to these parents as they learn to deal with their child's condition. We never know what to expect when we knock on the door.

Today was different. After a routine greeting with a mother, we were passing through the waiting room on our way to the next room to visit when a couple greeted us. They were waiting for results from their 8-year-old daughter who had contracted a virus that shut down her lungs and was beginning to attack other organs. As we were talking with them, staff called them into the room because their daughter was hungry and calling for them.

We hadn't visited the nearby Family Room for a long time, so we decided to drop in to say hello. As we were introducing ourselves to the volunteer at the desk, a lady got our attention to tell us that someone at one of the tables wanted to talk with us. We approached her and she asked, "Will you pray with me?" As it turns out she is the grandmother of a child who had been severely burned two or three years earlier and was going through more surgeries. She remembered us from before and she needed a friend.

I want to say that today was very different from most days, but I'm not so sure. We certainly happened to be in the right place at the right time, not by accident but by design.
