

Ardmore Baptist Church Re-Opening FAQs:

What are the details regarding in-person worship?

In-person worship has resumed on Sundays for the 10:45 service. Registration will be available for up to 100 people. Masks will be required and the facilities and services will provide for social distancing.

How do I register for in-person worship?

Details are outlined below for both online and phone registration. This information will also be available on our website each week. Please note that if you plan to attend in-person, you will need to register weekly for the following Sunday. Registrations may be submitted from Monday at 10:00 a.m. until Friday at 4:00 p.m. for up to 100 people.

Registration via phone:

- Call the church office (336) 725-8767
 - Include which service you want to attend
 - Include all names (family of 3 – need 3 names) of those planning to attend

How to Register using the link

- Click Registration link (on website, QuickBits, or Realm Events)
- Under Who is attending this event
 - Select each family member attending
 - Add guest (if applicable) and enter guest name
- Click Next
 - Screen will show who is being registered
- Click Next
 - Screen will change again
- Click Register
- You should receive an email confirming your registration

How to Register Using Realm App

- Go to Events
- Choose the service you want to attend (date and time)
- Click Register by (date)
- Scroll down to “Who is attending this event?”
- Click each family member that is attending
- Click Next
- Click Next
- Scroll down and click Register

When and where should I enter? What about parking and shuttles?

Doors will be open 30 minutes prior to the service. Please refer to the floorplan provided to note which entrances will be available to allow for optimal social distancing. Shuttle service from the remote lot will not be available at this time. Please consider parking in areas that are convenient to the open entrances (Sanctuary, Glass Doors beside the Sanctuary, Preschool, and lower level Portico).

When should I stay home?

We are asking that everyone continue to self-screen at home before you come to church. If you have a fever over 100 degrees, a cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, or contact with someone confirmed to have COVID-19 (in the past 14 days), please stay home and worship online.

Will childcare be available for these services?

Not at this time. Please follow us on Facebook, Instagram, and our website for any updates in the future.

What if I cannot or choose not to join worship in-person?

Will bulletins be available?

Can I still give my tithe/offering when I attend in-person worship?

Offering plates will not be passed; however, you will be able to drop your offering in the designated location as you enter the sanctuary. Envelopes will not be available, so please prepare accordingly.

What about giving for those who are not attending in person?
