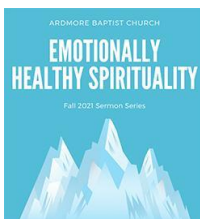

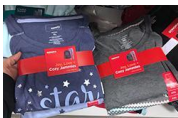
October Is Clergy Appreciation

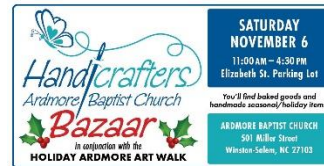
